Doves and Hawks

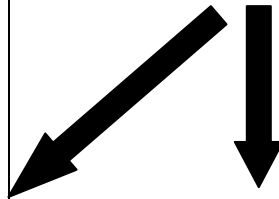
Doves

Began bombing Vietcong in Cambodia

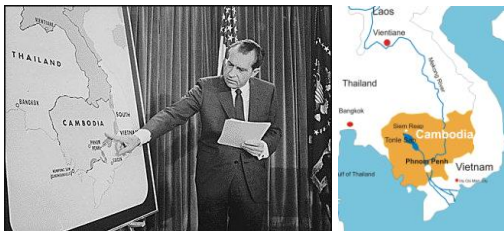

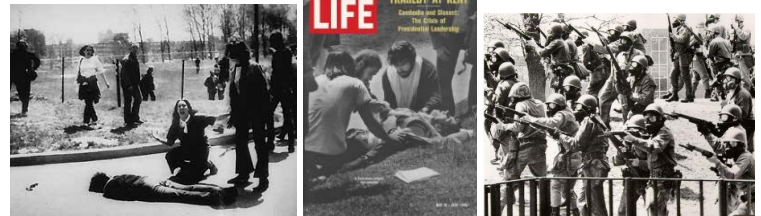

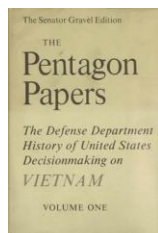

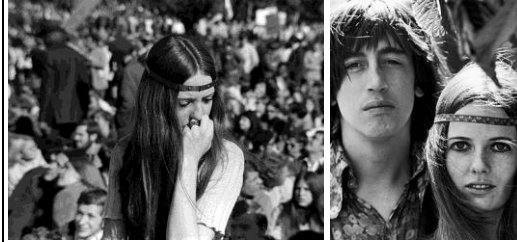
Capital of South Vietnam

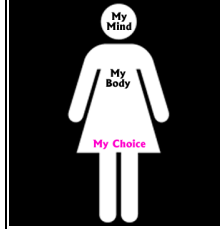


What is NOW?
