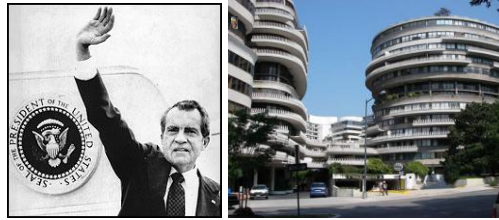

Executive Privilege



Recorded taping system that recorded White House conversations was discovered.

Did Nixon cover up the Watergate Scandal?

Nixon pleaded *executive privilege*.

Impeachment



What is the official charge of presidential misconduct?

Inflation

Causes: Deficit spending used to fund Vietnam War and Great Society program without raising taxes



More causes: large amounts of money pumped into the economy



and rising costs of raw materials due to greater competition

What is a rise in the cost of goods?

Embargo

Causes: OPEC stopped shipping petroleum to countries that supported Israel in the Middle East
Effect: Crude oil shortage causing prices to skyrocket by 70%, then another 130%



What is the stopping of shipping?

Stagflation



What is a puzzling economic dilemma that combines rising prices and economic stagnation?

Gerald Ford



- Replaced Vice President Spiro Agnew who was forced to resign in disgrace in 1973
- Replaced Nixon in 1974
- Approval ratings plummeted from 71 to 50% after pardon
- Known for bland personality: "I'm a Ford, not a Lincoln" "That Gerald Ford. He can't fart and chew gum at the same time." Lyndon Johnson
- One term president

"My fellow Americans, our long national nightmare is over."

Which republican president pardoned Nixon?

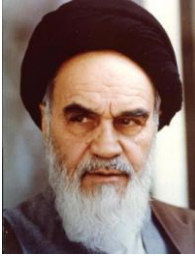
Jimmie Carter

- Peanut Farmer
- As President Ford, President Carter was unsuccessful to solve the economic problems
- Inexperienced and inability to work with Congress made him ineffective
- Popularity in 1979 lower than Nixon's during Watergate
- Attacked by a killer rabbit during a boating excursion
- One term president



Which president was a political outsider from Georgia known for his moral and honest nature?

Iran



- The U.S. supported the Shah (Iran's Monarch) because he was a major oil supplier and a buffer against Soviet expansion in the Middle East.
- The Shah was unpopular and fled the country
- Islamic leader: Ayatollah Khomeini
- Failed Rescue mission
- President Carter was unable to negotiate freedom for hostages
- In captivity for 444 days
- Released on the last day in office for President Carter

Gurus



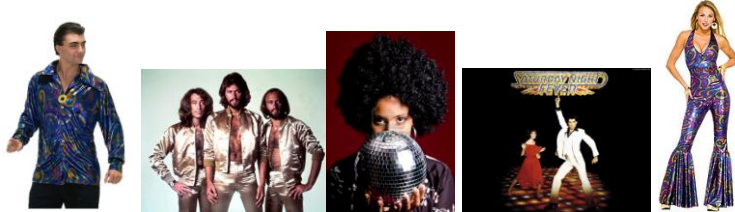
What is a mystical leader – many originating from Asia?
