


Nature smart: discriminate well among living things

•Write about nature, daily life, or people as a topic so you become engaged in your assignment.


## Possible opportunities

Botanists, biologists, farmer, naturalist, animal behaviorist, and scientist.


## You Are a Naturalistic Learner
